I understand that initial passing of the temperament evaluation does not guarantee continued participation in social activities and that Bonafide Dog Academy may change my dog's activity status at any time and for any reason. I understand that certain behaviors will disqualify my dog from receiving care at Bonafide Dog Academy outside of social activities.

C.) I understand that the Bonafide Day Academy program is, first and foremost, a daycare and enrichment program. While training is a large aspect of this program, it is not primarily a training program and is not intended to address serious behavioral concerns. I understand that the Bonafide Day Academy trainers will be working through a set curriculum with my dog and not a personalized program created to suit my personal goals. I understand that results are not guaranteed. I understand I will under no circumstances be entitled to a refund of services rendered or scheduled due to dissatisfaction with training results.

D.) I understand that there is inherent risk in participation in social activities, including but not limited to: fights, bites, contagious disease, parasites and emotional distress. I understand that while Bonafide Dog Academy takes precautions to minimize these risks, they cannot eliminate them. I give permission for my dog to participate in social activities at Bonafide Dog Academy with the knowledge that these risks exist. I hereby hold Bonafide Dog Academy and it's agents harmless in the event of any assumed risk during social activities.

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By signing above, I agree that:

I understand the results of my pet's Day Academy Evaluation. I have been made aware of my options for Day Academy and training going forward. If additional training has been recommended, I understand that the completion of a training program does not guarantee my dog will be approved to attend Day Academy and/or social activities. I understand that Bonafide Dog Academy reserves the right to change my dog's status at any time, which may include restriction from social activities, specific or all day services, group classes and private training.

I understand that failure to attend Day Academy regularly may result in temperamental changes. I understand that should I fail to bring my dog for 30 consecutive days, Bonafide Dog Academy will require another temperament evaluation prior to re-entering the program.

I understand that Bonafide Day Academy's group play policy is as follows:

- Any dog who has bitten another dog and caused damage requiring veterinary care in or outside of the facility will not, under any circumstances, be allowed into social play with other dogs at Bonafide Dog Academy.
- Dogs who show overarousal such as excessive mounting, posturing, growling (non-playful), excessive barking (non-playful), herding and other possibly dangerous behaviors will not be allowed in social play with other dogs.
- Social group play is meant for dogs who already enjoy and play appropriately with other dogs. The trainers will sometimes choose to create a socialization program for certain dogs who are not initially placed in the social play program, but this is entirely up to their discretion and does not guarantee that a dog will be placed into group play. There may be additional cost associated with these programs. This would be an optional service.
- For dogs who show barrier or leash frustration, the trainers may recommend utilizing a muzzle for re-evaluation in the future. It is the responsibility of the owner to purchase a PROPERLY SIZED and BITE PROOF muzzle recommended by the trainers if they would like to move forward with this plan. This does NOT guarantee that their dog will interact in social play in the future. The muzzle simply allows for an alternative temperament evaluation process.
